Commuting on base

If you are driving to work, please OBEY ALL SPEED LIMITS. There is an aggressive speed enforcement campaign during school hours. All drivers should have their license, registration and insurance in their vehicle at all times. Please remember that many of our students walk or bike to school and will be sharing the road with your vehicle. Drive safely and slowly.

If you have a military ID, that will be sufficient to drive on base. If not, please have your MCSD photo ID badge ready for the gate guard AND have your current Sigsbee Charter School car pass ready for the sentry. You will NOT be granted entry without these documents.

Your school ID grants you access as an individual. Anyone traveling with you must have a photo ID. Technically, you are not authorized to bring guests on base so there may be times when you will need to notify the office in order to gain access for your guests. We cannot guarantee they will be allowed on base. You are responsible for the behavior of any of your guests. Violations of any base rules may result in termination of your access, so please be prudent.

Two-Wheel Vehicles: bikes, motorcycles, scooters

Military installations have specific regulations regarding safety equipment required for riding two-wheel vehicles. If you are riding your bike to school, be sure to wear a helmet while on base and follow all traffic regulations.

Motorized two-wheel vehicles such as motorcycles and scooters require the operator to wear a long-sleeved shirt, long-sleeved pants, boots, and a helmet.
